

Friendship Knot Quilt Guild

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Cass Bowen. The Sew What's cottage group were hostesses. Cass welcomed all members and guests.

The September regular meeting minutes were posted on the website. Cass called for any corrections or additions. There being none the Minutes were approved as written. The September treasure's report has not yet been posted on the website but will be within the next few days. It will be filed for review by the Audit committee.

Kathy Lane reported that the block auctions must be entered by the November 15, 2012 Guild meeting.

Janine Ward thanked all donors for the Boutique items that have been turned in so far.

Elva Farrell asked for volunteers for selling raffle tickets at the Christmas in Pinecraft on Nov. 9 and 10th. There will be 2 shifts on each day. Contact Elva to sign up.

Ann Greene reported that anyone entering a quilt in the show must be a member of the Guild for 2012 and the deadline for membership is October 31, 2012. Membership dues can be mailed to Ann Greene and 2013 dues can be paid starting November 1st. She also announced that Quilter's Haven donated a sewing machine to FKQG to be raffled off at the show. The attendance for this meeting included 3 new members, 5 guests giving a total present at 109. The grand total of members is 269.

Trish Bobeck reported that the library has two new books that are available for check out.

Cass announced that Ellen Simon, the 1st Vice President was unable to attend the meeting. Future speakers and classes are posted on the website.
