Choose your favorite style of fabrics (Jan's uses rich, cool batiks) with contrast between light and dark. This quilt will sparkle with its many colors and values when you apply quick cutting and accurate piecing techniques.

Supply List:

- Sewing machine – Don't forget all your cords and foot pedal!
- Basic sewing tools – fabric scissors, thread, machine and hand sewing needles, seam ripper, etc.
- Rotary tools – cutter, mat, 6" X 12" ruler
- Fabric (NOTE: Fabric must be cut according to instructions prior to coming to class.)
- Notepad and pen or pencil for taking notes
- Optional: Craft light
- Optional: A small seat cushion for height and access to extra light

Almost Twilight

Un-mystery Version, Approx 61 x 61- inches

Fabric

- Background – $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (very light)
- Black – two yards (very dark)
- 12 pastel batiks in mediums and medium darks, or your choice of fabrics – $\frac{1}{4}$ yard each

Make sure all fabrics contrast somewhat with your light background.

(Batiks are recommended for this quilt because of their stability in working with bias.)

Supplies

- Sewing machine and extension cord
- Rotary cutter, mat and rulers

(Recommend companion angle by EZ International or some 90 degree triangle ruler)

- Sewing machine thread and full bobbins
- Basic sewing supplies
- Irons to share
- Magic sizing (spray fabric finish for ironing)

Pre-Cutting and Class Preparation

- Batiks: Cut 48 $1\frac{3}{4}$ inch strips
- Light background: Cut 36 squares, 3 by 3 inches and cut 36 rectangles, 3 by $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
- Dark star points: Cut 72 squares, 3 by 3 inches. Fold in half on the diagonal and gently iron these squares into triangles. Do not stretch!
- Cut eight 5-inch squares from dark fabric; then cut the squares, corner to corner on the diagonal into 16 triangles. Set aside.
- Cut one $1\frac{3}{4}$ inch strip of dark into 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ inch squares.
- You need 140 piano keys. Cut 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ inch strips into $6\frac{1}{2}$ inch segments for pieced border
- Borders: Cut 15 $1\frac{3}{4}$ inch dark strips for border treatment. (Can do later)
